| <b>Kirstenbosch National Botanical Gardens</b> | An African Villa                  | Yes              | Beautiful botanical gardens with rare local fauna. Nice for a picnic  |
| <b>V&amp;A Waterfront - Parking</b>            | An African Villa                  | Yes              | The V&A Waterfront is the tourist hub of Cape Town. A modern development looking onto the working harbour, there are lots of restaurants and shops. A nice place to have a meal and watch the world go by. Also where you catch ferries to Robben Island. One 'adventure' activity is to take a helicopter tour over Cape Town and the Peninsula. There are many parking areas, so use the device to get close to the Waterfront and then follow signs for parking. |
| <b>Table Mountain Cable Way</b>                | An African Villa                  | Yes              | This is the starting point to take a cable car up to the top of Table Mountain, which is highly recommend. The cable car is often closed due to bad weather, therefore I suggest taking the first opportunity when the weather is good. You can also hike to the top, but this is a very serious hike only for the very fit and not to be undertaken in bad weather.  |
| <b>Camps Bay Beach</b>                         | An African Villa                  | Yes              | This is our favourite beach in Cape Town. It has lovely white sand and where lots of the young and cool of Cape Town hangout. Lots of restaurants and bars for lunch or in particular sun-downers (the beach faces the setting sun). Clifton Beach (also saved as a destination) is also nice.  |
| <b>Lions Head Trail</b>                        | An African Villa                  | Yes              | A short, but hard walk to the top of Lions Head for a view across Table Bay and down the 12 Apostles Mountains. Take this road towards the start and then follow the signs. Allow 3+ hours in total.  |
| <b>Long Street</b>                             | An African Villa                  | No               | This is where most the bars and restaurants in Cape Town are. You would probably want to walk or take a short taxi ride here rather than driving (parking is difficult), so it's not saved in the device.   |
| <b>La Colombe Restaurant</b>                   | An African Villa                  | Yes              | La Colombe Restaurant is probably our favourite restaurant in Cape Town. It is in Constantia (the oldest wine growing region in SA, the other side of Table Mountain). Advance booking is required (contact us and we can make a booking if required) or even go here just to explore beautiful Constantia / do some wine tasting - for example 'Constantia Uitsig' is also saved in the device).   |
| <b>Mount Nelson Hotel</b>                      | An African Villa                  | Yes              | An institution in Cape Town - the Mount Nelson is the most grand hotel here and taking High Tea here is a colonial tradition. Worth booking ahead though (just contact us).   |
| <b>City Sight Seeing Bus</b>                   | An African Villa                  | No               | I strongly recommend doing this early on in your trip because it's a great introduction to Cape Town ( <a href="http://www.citysightseeing.co.za/">http://www.citysightseeing.co.za/</a> ). There are a number of route alternatives and you can walk to the bus station from An African Villa (ask for directions). District Six Museum is particularly recommended.   |
